

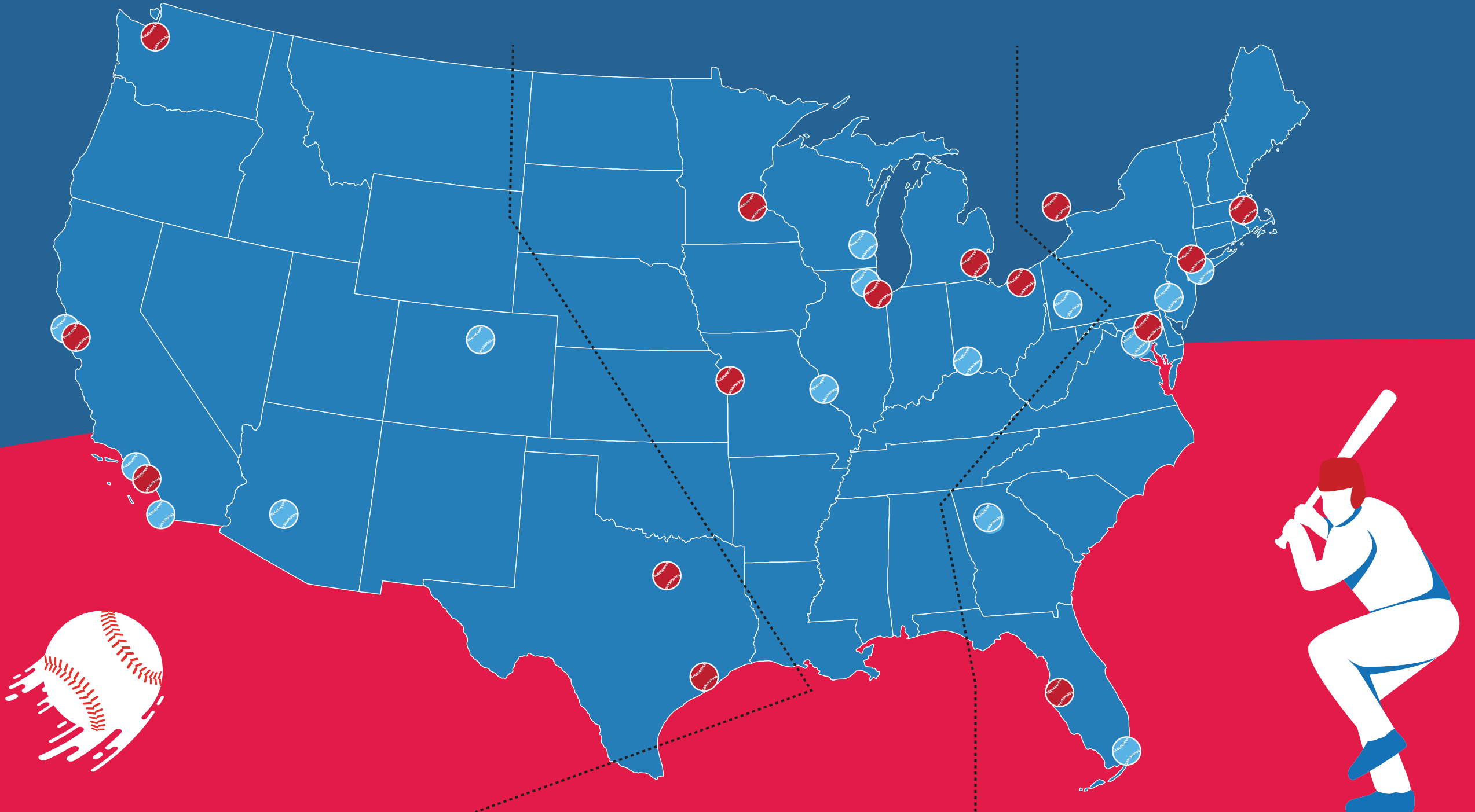
Baseball Is Back! All 30 Teams Play on Opening Day, March 28!
